## Information to discuss with the Board of Supervisors when you call, email or write a letter.

- 1. FEMA money has been allocated to fix the bridge.
- 2. FEMA money for the bridge may be at risk of being reallocated.
- 3. The bridge is critical for rapid response time during emergencies.
- 4. Emergency Access for community members.
- 5. Nielsen River Access Point for fishing boats, canoes, and kayaks.
- 6. Miles and time added to UPS deliveries
- 7. Access to cropland and cattle has been severely impacted by adding time and miles.
- 8. The Special Youth Challenge (SYC). This group is impacted by restricted access to hunting properties in the area.
- 9. The bridge is a critical access point connecting the community for businesses.
- 10. Frequently used as a photo setting for seniors, weddings, families, and photo enthusiasts.
- 11. Increased traffic near local poultry barns contributes to the spread of HPAI (highly pathogenic Avian Influenza) by facilitating the transmission of disease.
- 12. The Bridge is part of the High Bridge Wildlife Area.
- 13. UTV and ATV groups use the bridge as part of their route.
- 14. Historic Community Bridge should be repaired and maintained.
